



Annotation

Micraspis acicola Darker, Can. J. Bot. 41(10): 1390 (1963)

Family: *Leotiomyces*, *Micraspisdaceae*.

The morphology is as follows: *Saprobic* on needles of *Picea mariana*. **Sexual morph:** the apothecium on the host substrate was available on the slide preparat, hence, is not clear and the detail characters such as excipular cells, paraphysis, asci and ascospores can not be observed **Asexual morph:** Undetermined.

Material examined: CANADA, Ontario, North of long portage into Gull lake, Lake Temagami, Nipissing district on needles *Picea mariana*, 27 July 1927 G.D. Darker (CUP-054914).

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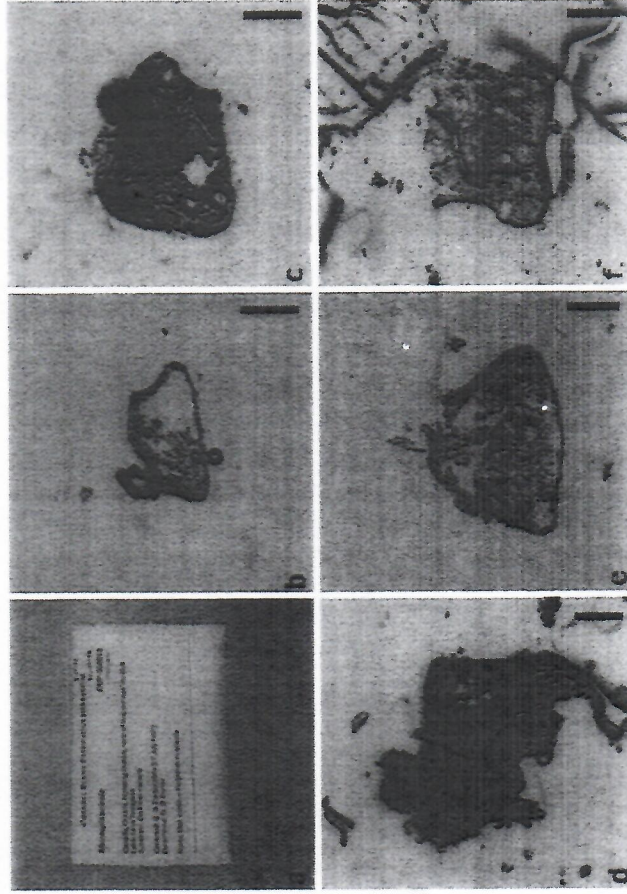


Fig. 1 .*Micraspis acicola* (CUP-054914, **holotype**) a. A herbarium package. b-d. host tissue bearing apothecium section e-f. Host tissue. Scale bars: b-f = 200 µm.
